



Winter Interest Plants

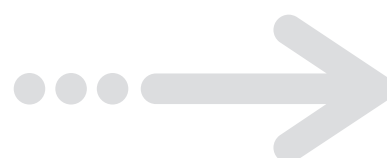

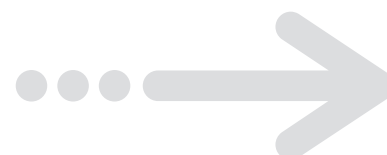

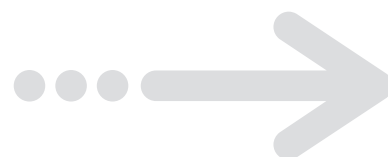
